

## Error Correction Card Game

Play this card game in groups of three or four. Shuffle the cards and place the deck in the middle. Player 1 takes a card and reads the sentence containing the error aloud. Players 2 and 3 try to provide the best oral correction of that sentence. Player 1 gives the card to the player whose correction matches the correction on the card. If both players answer correctly at the same time, Player 1 returns the card to the bottom of the deck. If neither player answers correctly, Player 1 reads the answer and returns the card to the bottom of the deck. The player to the left takes the next turn. The player with the most cards at the end is the winner.

This serious game provides useful practice correcting avoidable errors. Since only the correct answer can win the card, this game provides opportunities for peer-feedback on form in a safe and structured way. Since the cards do not provide explanations, the question “*Why?*” will arise naturally, creating the context for students to develop their metalinguistic awareness through discussion and their digital literacy through the judicious use of their cell phones to explore the *Virtual Writing Tutor grammar checker*.
